NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 22nd August, 1995

No. 12-2194-VCI/17092.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (i) read with clause (a) of sub-section (2) of section 66 of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 (52 of 1984), the Veterinary Council of India, with previous approval of the Central Government hereby makes the following regulations, namely:—

1. Short-title and commencement.—(1) These regulations may be called the Veterinary Council of India (Election of the President and Vice-President) Regulations, 1995.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions.—In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

- (a) 'Act' means the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 (52 of 1984);
- (b) 'Council' means the Veterinary Council of India;
- (c) 'Form' means a form annexed to these regulations;
- (d) 'Member' means a member of the Council;
- (e) 'President' means the President of the Council;
- (f) 'Returning Officer' means the Secretary of the Council for the purpose of these regulations;

(g) 'Vice-President' means the Vice-President of the Council.

## 3. Election of President —

(1) The President of the Council shall be elected by the members present at the time of election, from amongst themselves.

(2) The date, time and place of the election shall be intimated, to each of the member of the Council by the Secretary of the Council, who shall also perform the functions of the Returning Officer for this purpose.

(3) (i) Any member present shall be entitled to propose the name of any other member present, for election as the President.

(ii) The proposal shall be required to be seconded by a member other than the proposer or the one whose name is proposed:

Provided that one member shall be entitled to propose or second only one name.

(4) Any candidate may withdraw his candidature before the actual election.

(5) If the name of only one candidate is duly proposed and seconded, the Returning Officer shall forth with declare, in form 'B', such candidate as duly elected.

(6) If the number of candidates proposed and seconded exceeds one, an election shall be held by secret ballot.

(7) Before the commencement of the election, the Returning Officer shall invite the members to inspect the ballot box, in case they like to do so, and he shall then lock the ballot box.

(8) (i) At the time of actual election, the members present in the meeting shall, one by one, sign against their names in the list containing names of all the members in alphabetical order and placed alongside the ballot box.

(ii) After a member has signed against his name in the list afore-mentioned he shall be given a ballot paper in form 'A' which he shall drop into the ballot box after affixing thereon a cross (x) mark against the name of the candidate of his choice.

(9) As soon as all the Members present and wishing to exercise the right to vote have done so, the Returning Officer shall, in the presence of the candidates who may be present in person, open the ballot box and take out from it all the ballot papers, examine them and reject as invalid any ballot paper—

- (a) if it does not bear the signature of the Returning Officer; or
- (b) if the member signs his name or writes any word or make any mark on it by which it becomes recognisable as his ballot paper; or
- (c) if no vote is recorded thereon; or
- (d) if the vote is recorded in such a manner as to make it doubtful as to which candidate the vote has been given; or

(e) if the vote has been given in favour of more than one candidate.

(10) (i) The Returning Officer shall then proceed to arrange the valid votes according to the candidates in whose favour they have been cast and count them separately for each candidate.

(ii) After the counting is over, the Returning Officer shall make an announcement in the meeting about the votes secured by each of the candidates.

(iii) The Returning Officer shall declare, in form 'B', the candidate securing the highest number of valid votes as duly elected to be the President of the Council.

(iv) In the event of two or more candidates securing the same number of votes and that number being more than the number of votes secured by any candidate other than the two or more securing the same number of votes, the determination as between such candidates shall be draw of lots and the candidate on whom the lot falls, shall be declared elected.

4. Election of Vice-President.—The provisions regarding election of President specified in regulation 3 shall 'mutatis mutandis' apply to the election of the Vice-President.
