MURRAH BUFFALO	Rohtak, Jind, Bhiwani, Sonapat, Jhajjar, Gurgon, Hissar districts of Haryana. Parts of Delhi and Meerut, Gaziabad, Bulandshahar, Muzzaffar Nagar districts of western U.P.	Jet black and massive with long and deep body. Head of females short, fine and clear cut. Horns are tightly curved in a spiral form. Eyes are bright prominent.

Identification and location of superior indigenous germ plasm of cattle and buffalo for the breeding programme and conservation, development of important indigenous breeds of cattle and buffalo.

- **Cataloguing of superior germ plasm of the selected breeds in their breeding tracts as well as breeding farms through milk recording and registration.**
- **To disseminate information on registered animals for sourcing of breeding material.**
- **To promote conservation of selected indigenous breeds by providing incentives to breeders.**
- **To propagate and awaken consciousness amongst the breeders to improve their economics through livestock improvement by constant publicity, incentive and formation of breeder associations.**

- **To undertake the animals for Primary Registration and milk record.**

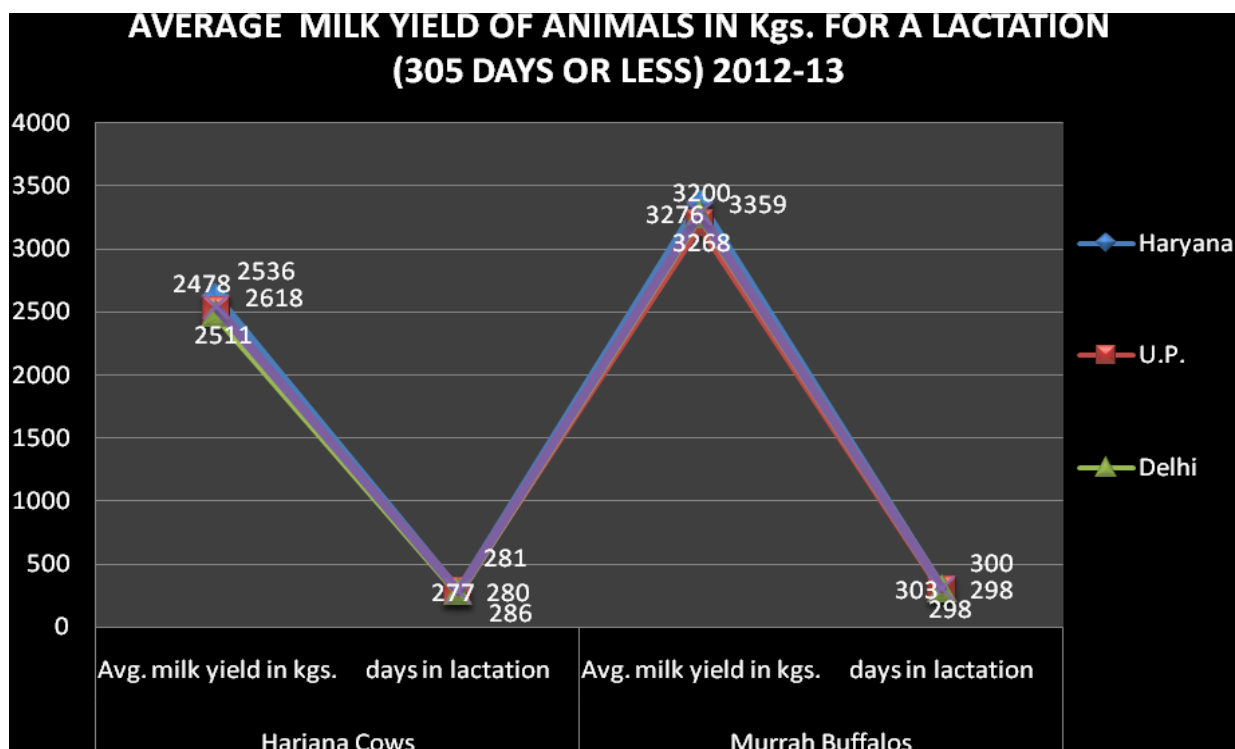

A herd book was maintained, with the lists of animals with superior qualities of known parentage belonging to a pure breed. This was an essential step towards improvement of the economic qualities of cattle. Inclusion of animals in a herd book does not indicate that it is of an exceptionally high quality but only that it belongs to a pure breed and that its parentage is known. Herd books are correlated with the milk records of the animals concerned so that an examination of these books, in conjunction with that of the milk records of the animals, enables one to obtain particulars concerning both their parentage and their quality. The unit starts function in the year 1963-64.

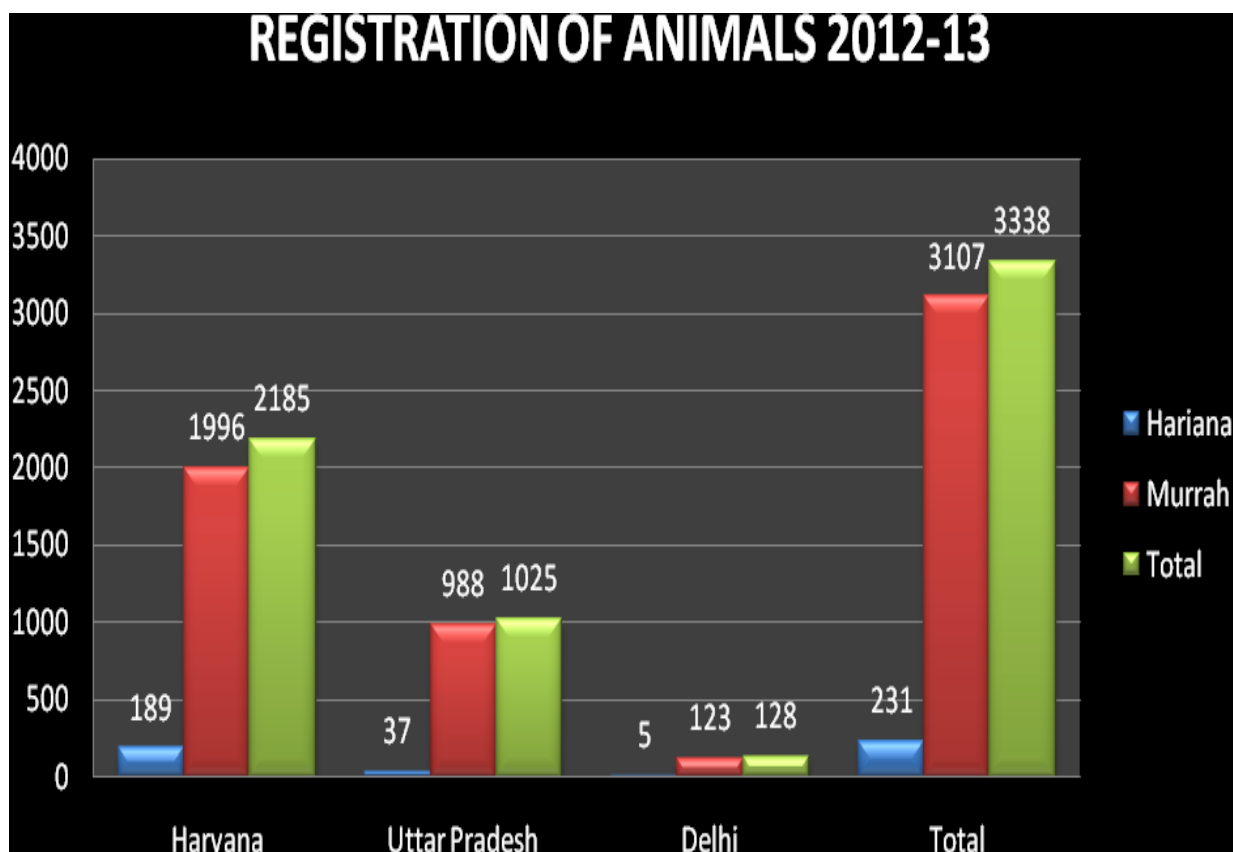

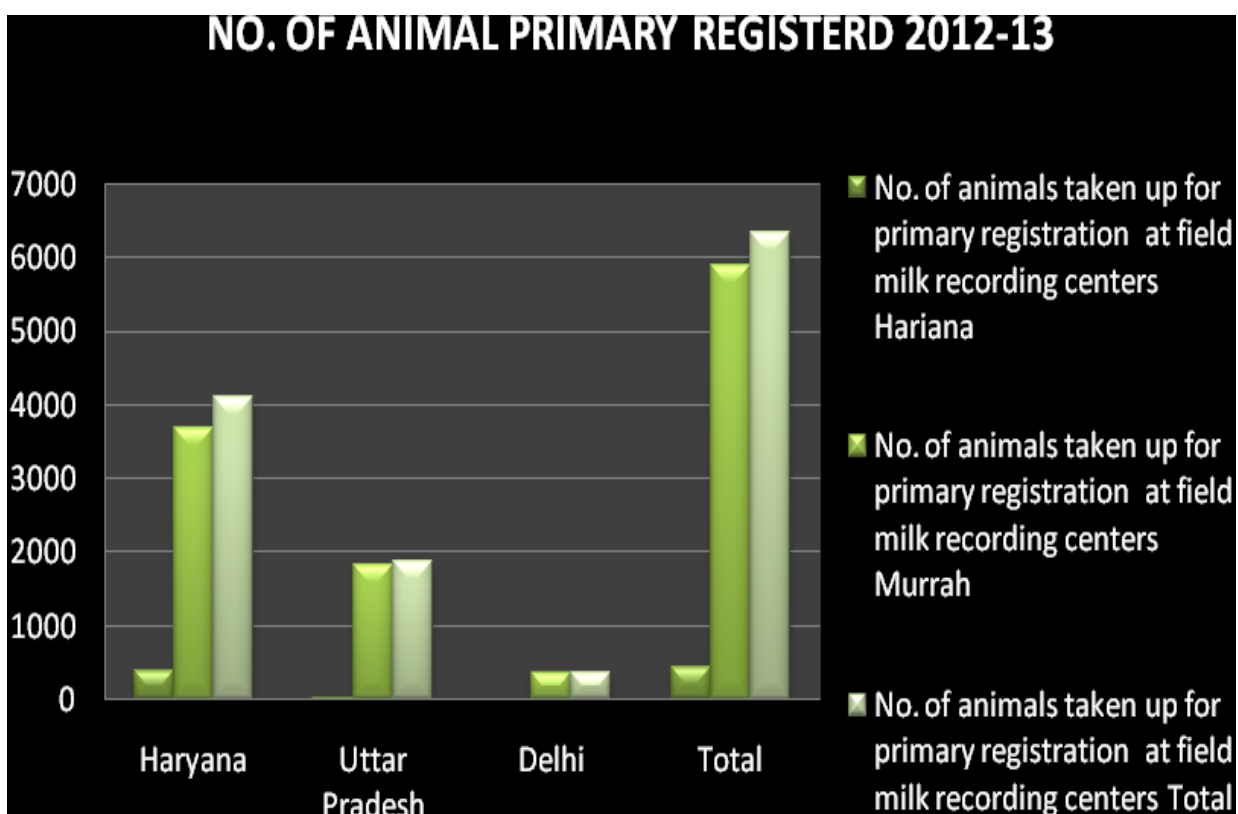

HOW TO REACH US

Roads

Rohtak is connected to seven cities by three national highways ([NH10](#), NH71, and NH71A) and two State Highways (SH16 and SH18). National Highway 10 from New Delhi to Rohtak is being upgraded to six lanes with 30 km Rohtak City Bypass, so that the vehicles traveling between New Delhi and [Hissar](#) do not have to enter Rohtak city. National Highway 10 from Rohtak to Hissar and several cities of [Punjab](#) is being widened to a four-lane highway.

Railway

Rohtak City is connected to New Delhi, [Bahadurgarh](#), [Bhiwani](#), [Jind](#), [Gohana](#), and [Panipat](#) by rail. Delhi-Rohtak-Jakhal-Bhatinda railway line is double tracked, the other railway lines like Rohtak-Panipat are of single track. A new railway line from Rohtak to [Rewari](#) via [Jhajjar](#) has become operational from January 2013.
