

Delhi Milk Scheme (DMS)

Delhi Milk Scheme (DMS) was set up in 1959 with the primary objective of supplying wholesome milk to the Citizens of Delhi at reasonable prices as well as for providing remunerative prices to milk producers. The Dairy Plant in DMS was initially set up with the capacity of 2.55 lakh litres of milk per day for processing and packing of milk. However in order to meet growing demand for milk in the city, the capacity of Dairy Plant was expanded in phases up to the level of five lakh litres of milk per day. The Dairy Plant has license under Food Safety and Standard Act-2006 and awarded ISO 22000-2005 and ISO 14001-2004 certifications by M/s IRQS Mumbai.

Delhi Milk Scheme is procuring raw/fresh milk from the State Dairy Federations of the neighboring States of Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Bihar. It is processing and supplying milk (Toned, Double Toned and Full Cream) to the consumers and Govt. Institutions in Delhi. DMS is also manufacturing & marketing Dahi, Ghee, Butter, Paneer, Chhach and Flavored Milk for supply to the citizens of Delhi. DMS has a network of over 1110 all day milk stalls and also supply milk to the Institutions like Hospitals, Parliament House, Government Canteen, hostels and Defense units including supply to the consumers through milk distributor. The milk booths of DMS are allotted to Ex-serviceman /Retired Govt. Servants, Physically Handicapped, Widows and Unemployed Persons.
