ORDER

Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) approved by the Government of India provides identification and notification of a suitable Nodal Implementing Agency (NIA) at the national level for implementation of the FIDF. Consequent to approval of FIDF, the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare hereby notify the National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad as a Nodal Implementing Agency(NIA) with immediate effect till further order.

2. The Nodal Implementing Agency(NIA) would act as a technical arm for implementation of FIDF. NIA would be responsible for techno-financial evaluation of the proposals, formulation of operational guidelines, formulation of annual action plans, overall coordination, interface with various organisations/stakeholders, outcome focused monitoring of all activities of the FIDF or any others, as may be required for smooth implementation of the FIDF. Besides, NIA shall assist the DADF in overall monitoring of the FIDF, formulation of annual budgetary proposals and releases of interest subvention and funds to the NLEs and other agencies as may be required at central level. NIA is to assist the Central Approval and Monitoring (CAMC) in the matter of scrutinizing the proposals on techno-financial angles.
