Sub: Release of Funds as second instalment to States for implementation of Foot and Mouth Disease Control Programme (FMD-CP), under Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Livestock Health & Disease Control" during 2017-18 –regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for the payment of Grants-in-Aid amounting to Rs.1000.61 lakh (Rupees Ten Crore and sixty-one thousand Only) as Central Grants to the Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services of State Governments of Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Punjab as second instalment of 60% Central share for procurement of FMD vaccine and towards meeting expenditure on logistics for carrying out vaccination under Foot and Mouth Disease Control Programme (FMD-CP) during 2017-18 with the condition that matching 40% State share is to be provided by the State Governments so as to carry out vaccination of all eligible animals as envisaged under the programme as per schedule of vaccination:
