Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to convey the sanction of the President of India for the payment of Grants-in-Aid amounting to Rs. 14.00 (Rupees Fourteen lakh only) to the Nagaland State Govt. towards expenditure on the "National control Programme of Classical Swine Fever–Control Programme" (NCP-CSF), which is a component of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Livestock Health and Disease Control' for the current Financial Year (2017-18) with the condition that 10% matching share will be provided by the State Government.

2. The Grants-in-Aid of Rs. 14.00 (Rupees Fourteen lakh only) have been released in accordance with the approved pattern of financial assistance under the Scheme. The release to the Nagaland State Govt. has been made with the condition that the next instalment for release will be considered only after obtaining the information relating to fund-utilization and submission of Utilization Certificate by the Nagaland State Govt.




