I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for payment of Grant-in-Aid amounting to Rs. 5.00 lakh (Rupees Five lakh only) as Central Grants to State Government of Madhya Pradesh for meeting expenditure under "Livestock Health & Disease Control" under component "National Project on Rinderpest Surveillance and Monitoring" (NPRSM), broadly as per the work plan and budget of the project component of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme during the financial year 2017-2018.

2. The Grants-in-Aid of Rs. 5.00 Lakh (Rupees Five Lakh only) have been released in accordance with the approved pattern of financial assistance under the Scheme. The release to the Madhya Pradesh State Government is subject to the condition that the next instalment for release will be considered only after obtaining the information relating to fund-utilization and submission of Utilization Certificate by the Madhya Pradesh State Government.

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

6. This Sanction is issued in exercise of delegated powers and with the concurrence of Finance Division of Ministry of Agriculture, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries vide their Diary No. 1767/AC(B) dated 19.03.2018.
7. The audited figures of expenditure of the current financial year as well as previous years may please be furnished.
8. It is certified that no Utilization Certification is pending with the above mentioned States / UTs as due for rendition under the Rules under the scheme.
