

3. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts during the year 2017-18

00101 : Veterinary Services and Animal Health (Minor Head)
36 : White Revolution- Rashtriya Pashudhan Vikas Yojana
03 : Livestock Health and Disease Control
36 : Salaries

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4. The grant is subject to the following terms and conditions:-
 - i. This grant shall be utilized by the Veterinary Council of India for furthering the objectives of the approved scheme.
 - ii. The Veterinary Council of India shall maintain proper account of the expenditure incurred and submit the statement of audits accounts to the Govt. of India within prescribed period but not later than 12 months after the end of each year.
 - iii. The audited records of all assets (permanents and semi-permanent) acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant should be available for Scrutiny by audit.
 - iv. The assets referred to above, shall, not without the prior approval to the Govt. of India, be disposed off, encumbered or, utilized for the purposes other than those for which the Grant-in-Aid is sanctioned.
 - v. The balance, if any, remaining unspent at the close of the financial year 2017-18 will be reported to this Ministry so that it may be taken into while sanctioning further grants.
