The undersigned official veterinarian certifies that the product described above satisfies the following requirements:

- i) The country of import / origin is free from Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE)

Or

Bovine serum has been obtained from the cattle which were not subjected to a stunning process, prior to slaughter, with a device injecting compressed air or gas into the cranial cavity, or to a pithing process.

- ii) The consignment should be accompanied with a certificate of quality analysis mentioning that the serum is free from the pathogens especially Bovine Viral Diarrhea.
- iii) Serum would be used for the intended purpose only.

Post Import Requirements

- i) The release of imported serum at air port / sea port cargo should follow the same principles as are followed for veterinary biological or antigens by the Assistant Drug Controller of India at the air-port / sea -port.
- ii) The imported consignment should be cleared by the quarantine officer after verifying the sanitary certificate with the above cited sanitary conditions from the country of origin.
