**MEAT SHOPS REGISTERED UNDER FOOD SAFETY AND STANDARD  
REGULATION**

1536 SHRI SHAKTISINH GOHIL:

Will the Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of meat/poultry shops registered under Food Safety and Standard Regulations as on 31.03.2022, State-wise;
- (b) the number of meat/poultry shops that do not procure the meat/poultry meat from registered slaughter houses, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the action taken against such meat/poultry shops and how many such shops were closed?

- (a) As per the information received from the Food Safety Standards Authority of India , number of registered meat/poultry shops State-wise as on 31.03.2022 is at Annexure I
- (b) The information is not maintained by the Central Government.
- (c) Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has laid down the standards for meat and meat products under Regulation No. 2.5 of Food Safety and Standards (Food Products Standards & Food Additives) Regulations, 2011, which are required to be complied by Food Business Operators (FBOs), engaged in Meat and Meat Products.

In addition, FSSAI has prescribed guidelines on Specific Hygienic and Sanitary practices to be followed by FBOs engaged in manufacture, processing, storing and selling of Meat and Meat Products.

The implementation and enforcement of Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 primarily rests with the State/ UT Governments.

Random sampling and testing of food products including meat and meat products are being done by the officials of Food Safety Departments of the respective States/ UTs to check compliance of the standards laid down under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, Rules and Regulations made thereunder. In cases where the food samples are found to be non-conforming, recourse is taken to penal provisions under Chapter IX of the FSS Act, 2006. The total number of Inspections done State-wise for compliance of the prescribed norms and standards for the year 2020-2021 is at **Annexure-II**.
