- (a) The Prevention of Cruelty to Animal (Regulation of Livestock Market) Rules, 2017 was notified vide GSR 494(E) dated 23rd May, 2017 under Prevention of Cruelty to Animal Act, 1960. The Rules came into force from the date of notification. Rules are to be implemented by each State.
