FMD VACCINES

425.Dr. AMAR PATNAIK:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING
be pleased to state

- a) the details of the districts that have achieved 100 percent Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) vaccination of the bovine population
- b) the details of cattle deaths registered due to FMD vaccine, district wise;
- c) whether Government is aware of the non-supply of FMD vaccine under the National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) phase-II to the State of Odisha; and
- d) If so, the steps taken for timely release?

- (a) As per information gathered, the following districts have achieved 100 percent FMD vaccination in 2nd round of NADCP which commenced in July 2021 across the country-

East Delhi, West Delhi, Srinagar, Anantnag, Budgam, Baramulla, Bandipora, Ganderbal, Kupwara, Kulgam, Pulwama, Gautam Buddha Nagar, Ghaziabad, Hapur, Meerut, Muzaffarnagar, Rampur, Shamli, Salem, Madurai, Nilgiris, Vellore, Erode, Coimbatore, Karur and Tiruppur.

- (b) Based on information collected from States & UTs, only Kerala has reported cattle deaths due to FMD vaccination during the current FMD vaccination phase under National Animal Disease Control programme (NADCP). Districtwise details is as under:
